The regular monthly meeting of the Oxford Board of Port Wardens was called to order by the chairman, Thomas Campbell, on Thursday, March 5, 2009 at 7:00 p.m., in the meeting room of the Oxford Community Services Building.

The only other board member in attendance was Larry Murray.

The minutes of the meeting of February 12, 2009 were approved and accepted as distributed with the following corrections: Page 1, 4<sup>th</sup> paragraph, 5<sup>th</sup> sentence should read "The new bulkhead located 18" further out seems to be typical of most bulkhead replacements." On page 2, last sentence of the first paragraph, the figure "62 inches wide" should be "48 inches wide," and also on page 2, second paragraph, the last three sentences should be changed around to read as follow: "Mr. Murray suggested Mr. Case talk to the Town Administrator, Lillian Lord, and get her to bring this up to the Commissioners to see if it would be viable. Mr. Case Agreed to do so. Mr. Campbell responded that Mr. Case should look into discussing his permits with the MDE first and then put in an application for the permit. Mr. Case retorted that he did not want to submit an application and then have it disapproved because of something he hadn't disclosed or done ahead of time."

The members briefly re-visited permit #08-03 for Margaret Begor, at 101 Bayview Ave., with regards to a memo they had received from her husband, Rob Begor, concerning progress on their rip-rap project. The members found everything to be in order.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
