MINUTES

FEBRUARY 1, 2016

The regular monthly meeting of the Oxford Historic District Commission was called to order by the chairman, Thomas Costigan, Monday, February 1, 2016, at 5 p.m., in the meeting room of the Oxford Community Services Building.

Other commission members in attendance were Suzanne Litty, Jennifer Stanley, Patricia Ingram, and James Deerin.

The minutes of the meeting of January 4, 2016 were approved and accepted and distributed.

The following building permit was reviewed by the commission:

1. Permit #16-02, Oxford Arms Condo Association, 303 Market Street, replace existing Oxford Arms Condominium sign with new sign in same location. The permit was presented by one of the members of the association, Sis Everly. Ms. Everly explained that the association was looking to replace their existing Oxford Arms location sign with a new one, having the same measurement and location as their existing one. A motion was made to approve the sign as presented. It was seconded and unanimously carried without further discussion.

This concluded the review of building permits.

Mr. Costigan reminded the members that there will be a workshop meeting of the HDC with the Commissioners and Planning Commission on February 16 to discuss Demolition by Neglect. There was also a brief discussion of "The Mews" planning group meeting and activity with other commercial properties in town.
