

October 4, 2018

The regular meeting of the Oxford Port Wardens was called to order by the chairman, Thomas Campbell on Thursday, October 4, 2018, in the meeting room of the Oxford Municipal Building.

Other board members in attendance were Lawrence Murray and Robert Hyberg.

The minutes of June 7, 2018 were approved and accepted as distributed.

A consultation was held with Edmund Cutts, Jr., owner and operator of Cutts and Case Marina located on Tilghman Street. Mr. Cutts met with the board to discuss the possibility of installing a travel lift on his property and brought along with him some concept drawings of his intentions. His plans were to install the lift on the west side of his property which abuts another maritime property. Mr. Campbell stated he had looked at Mr. Cutts' property and the area in which Mr. Cutts was looking to place a travel lift. He noted that the setback between maritime properties needed only to be 2'. Mr. Campbell offered some advice such as having staging areas near the boat lift. He also added that it looked as though Mr. Cutts could easily meet the setbacks and suggested that Mr. Cutts consider giving himself a little extra room instead of closing in at the 2' setback. Mr. Cutts also asked about boat lifts and the board confirmed with Mr. Cutts that boat lifts were not allowed on Town Creek.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
