**A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF OXFORD ADOPTING THE
2022 TALBOT COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION & COMMUNITY RESILIENCE PLAN
AS THE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF OXFORD**

WHEREAS, The Town of Oxford, a Maryland municipal corporation located within the geographical limits of Talbot County, Maryland, recognizes that the Federal Disaster Act of 2000 requires that all states and local jurisdictions develop, submit, and update a hazard mitigation plan that may reduce the impacts of hazards; and

WHEREAS, an adopted hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future federal funding for hazard mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Oxford participated in the planning process along with other municipal corporations located with Talbot County, Maryland, to prepare the 2022 Talbot County Hazard Mitigation & Community Resilience Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Oxford feels the 2022 Talbot County Hazard Mitigation & Community Resilience Plan fairly represents the interest of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Oxford that the Town of Oxford hereby adopts the 2022 TALBOT COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION & COMMUNITY RESILIENCE PLAN, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein, as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan for the Town of Oxford; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Talbot County Department of Emergency Services is authorized to submit on behalf the Town of Oxford, the adopted 2022 TALBOT COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION & COMMUNITY RESILIENCE PLAN to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for final review and approval, and application within the Town of Oxford.
