AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF OXFORD TO ADOPT UPDATED HISTORIC DISTRICT GUIDELINES AND TO REPEAL ALL PRIOR HISTORIC DISTRICT GUIDELINES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Land Use Article § 8-101, eq seq., the Town of Oxford has established a Historic District and a Historic District Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Historic District Commission has prepared updated Historic District Guidelines to provide current and prospective owners with guidance, in a clear and concise format, in planning new structures, as well as alterations and additions to existing buildings within the Historic District; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with <u>Md. Code Ann.</u> Land Use Article § 8-301, the Commissioners of Oxford have determined that it is desirable and in the public interest to adopt the updated Historic District Guidelines as recommended by the Oxford Historic District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF OXFORD AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Town of Oxford Historic District Commission Guidelines, dated July, 2014, Edition 4, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, are hereby adopted.

Section 2: Section 31.20 of the Oxford Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

§ 31.20 - Historic District Guidelines in Effect

The design guidelines for rehabilitation of structures, modification of structures, and new construction within the Oxford Historic District, are those guidelines *recommended* adopted by the Historic District Commission in 2014 2006, initially approved and adopted by the Commissioners of Oxford *pursuant Ordinance* 1407. on April 11, 2006, a copy of which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference, and will *The Guidelines* shall be included as an appendix to Section 31 of the Oxford Zoning Ordinance.
