A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF OXFORD TO ESTABLISH THE R GORDON GRAVES COMMUNITY SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM PROVIDING STUDENTS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THEIR PURSUIT OF HIGHER EDUCATION

WHEREAS, the Oxford community lost an honored elected official, a dedicated public servant, and a beloved fellow citizen, with the passing of former Oxford Commissioner R Gordon Graves on December 25, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Oxford desire to honor Gordon Graves, loving known as G1 in his elected capacity, in a manner that will continue his legacy of providing unwavering service to his community by encouraging the same of others; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have determined that it is desirable and in the public interest to establish the R Gordon Graves Community Service Scholarship Program honoring former Commissioner R Gordon Graves;
