



Resolution 2402 of the Commissioners of Oxford Recognizing the Cadet 2nd Philip R. Horner

WHEREAS, since Civil Air Patrol's formation during the early days of World War II, this vigilant organization of citizen airmen has been committed to mobilize the nation's civilian aviation resources for national service; and

WHEREAS, as a Total Force partner and auxiliary of the U.S. Air Force, its more than 64,000 members selflessly devote their time, energy, and expertise toward the well-being of their communities while also promoting aviation and related fields through aerospace/STEM education, and helping shape future leaders through CAP's Cadet program; and

WHEREAS, CAP's Brigadier General Billy Mitchell Award honors a fearless pilot whose patriotism, foresight, and tenacity surpassed the ridicule he faced; and

WHEREAS, the Mitchell Award is a significant milestone in CAP's cadet program, recognizing sustained excellence in all four areas of cadet life: leadership, aerospace, fitness, and character; and

WHEREAS, cadets receiving the Mitchell award must have passed comprehensive examinations on leadership and aerospace topics, and have completed a week-long encampment immersing them in a challenging Core Values and STEM environment; and

WHEREAS, only 15% of cadets in CAP's cadet program have received this award and Cadet Second Lieutenant Philip R. Horner is the 75,999th recipient since its establishment in 1964; and

WHEREAS, Philip R. Horner is a resident of the Oxford, Maryland community.

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, THE COMMISSIONERS OF OXFORD, do hereby recognize Cadet 2nd Philip R. Horner for this significant achievement which reflects great credit upon himself, his family, and our historic town.
